Standard admission fees of \$4.50-\$6.50 allow access to the Cherokee Middle-class Cabin, museum, film, historic grounds, and nature trail. New Echota State Historic Site attracts almost 10,000 visitors annually, including hundreds of students of all ages from area public and private schools. The site is located one mile east of I-75, exit 317, on GA Hwy. 225N.
