



TEN FOR 2010 PROJECT PRIORITIES

1. Acquire an **LCD projector** computer, monitor, keyboard, mouse, printer, and scanner for the purpose of conducting FONE business, including preparation of promotional materials and making presentations at schools, civic organizations, etc. [Note: this goal has been partially achieved through donations. We still need an **LCD projector**.]
2. Refurbish interpretive garden at the Cherokee Middle Class Homestead, consisting primarily of raising the level of the planting bed, soil testing, and soil amendments as necessary
3. Provide financial assistance for programming throughout the year
4. Acquire historic clothing, accessories, and patterns for volunteers
5. Design and invest in FONE branded products for resale, such as t-shirts, caps, pens, bottled water
6. Acquire a storage building for FONE equipment, historic clothing, resale inventory and other materials
7. Install permanent labels identifying and describing native plants and trees on the trails
8. Produce an audio self-guided tour and acquire the needed equipment in order to enhance the experience of New Echota visitors
9. Acquire FONE banner(s), display table(s), brochures and canopy for the purpose of increasing membership, distributing information, and fundraising at New Echota programs and local and regional events
10. Acquire donation box with lock to be installed in the lobby of the visitor center
